Overview:

Spectra is searching for several **laborer positions** for our operation at **Fair Park**, located in **Dallas, TX**. The **laborer position** is responsible for assisting in the daily upkeep of the grounds and appearance of the park by performing a wide range of landscape and irrigation duties.

Responsibilities:

- Performs landscape duties including but not limited to mowing, edging, trimming, aerating, top dressing, laying down sod and mulch, planting flowers, cleaning up debris, digging, blowing leaves, pulling weeds, watering plans etc.
- Uses hand tools such as shovels, rakes, pruning equipment, hedge, or brush trimmers to perform a wide range of landscape and irrigation duties.
- Takes care of all equipment and materials used in performing landscaping duties
- Clears sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots of debris.
- Performs loading and unloading of equipment, tools, materials, and debris to and from vehicles
- Performs minor repairs and maintenance procedures on equipment used
- Follows company's safety policies, guidelines, and instructions
- Practices consistent dependability, attendance and adheres to work schedules
- May assist in minor exterior repairs as needed
- Other duties as assigned
